- Evaluations
 - ◆ Discussed update/follow-up formats
- Treatment and Treatment Providers
 - ◆ Treatment progression reports
 - Form is very simple
 - Good collapse of what to cover
 - Copy for client
 - ⊕ Inform of progression
- Quality Assurance Procedures
 - ◆ Discussed on-site/office audits
 - ◆ Records retention
 - ◆ Selection process for audit reviews
 - 33% every 3 years

VII. ATSA Conference Recap

- Harris: When is a sex offender not a sex offender
 - ◆ Study: After 19 years in the community sex offenders become less likely to reoffend with a sexual offense
- Juvenile tools
 - ◆ Guided by clinical judgment
 - ◆ JSORRAT-II
 - No studies in Idaho
 - Cannot be included in a report
 - Not normed nationally
- Breakout on effectiveness of the registry
- Juveniles are not the same as adults
- Juvenile polygraphs: To do or not: consider maturity level
- Assessing progress in treatment with juveniles
 - ◆ Righthand Scale
 - Treatment progress scale
 - Working to norm
 - ◆ Periodic could be RHS
 - Better than RRASOR/J-SOAP
- Females
 - ◆ Only one place working on females
 - ◆ Iowa 8
 - A tool they claim can be used on males, females, and juveniles
 - Population is small
 - Have demonstrated that it is predictive
 - Have provided stats comparing Static 99
 - Same questions regardless of population
 - Pared down version of Iowa 12
 - ◆ STABLE has some validity
