I. Call to Order

- Chairman Evans called the full-board meeting to order at 09:26 a.m.

II. Approval of board meeting minutes

Mr. Burnham motioned to approve minutes from the June 6, 2014 board meeting. Seconded by Mr. Betts; motion carried unanimously.

III. Old Business

➤ Training Update:

- ◆ Received first five training proposals from Mr. Prescott and Dr. Wilson
- ◆ Will have the Board review
- ◆ SOMB will own the materials and identify people to present trainings
- ◆ Once final product is received, trainings will begin on a monthly cycle

IV. Juvenile Registration Proposal – Ms. Nancy Bishop, IDJC Deputy Attorney General

- Received a copy of the proposed Juvenile Sex Offender Registration Act changes
 - ◆ SOMB recommendations were presented to the juvenile registration workgroup
 - ◆ Those suggestions were incorporated into the document
 - ◆ Psychosexual Evaluation will determine risk level; court will decide registration level
 - ◆ Juveniles will remain under the jurisdiction of the Magistrate Court, Juvenile Division until reaching age 21

The Department of Juvenile Corrections has opted to move forward with this proposed legislation, and is asking for SOMB support.

Sheriff Huff Motions: Approve the proposal with these adjustments and support IDJC in moving forward. Ms. Fisher seconded the motion.

 - ◆ Ms. Bishop and Ms. Sharon Harrigfeld, Director, IDJC, will present this registration proposal to the Idaho Sheriff's Association and subsequent groups for familiarization and support
 - ◆ Juveniles will register annually

All members present voted to support IDJC legislation proposal with discussed adjustments.
